Supporting more than 7000 Migrant families.

- PREDO successfully involved the Community including school community, religious priests and religious institutions in supporting the DPM concept: 7176 programs with 176,453 participants
- Rate of LM related legal cases handled and resolved 719 cases out of 722 cases received found solution 9% within three years.
- More than 50%^ sub agent trained and made positive partners in safe migration.
- Complaints against Sub agents reduced to 78 in 2013 to 00 in 2019.
- 781 psyco-social cases handled in 6 years from 2013-2019
- Ensuring pre-departure training to more than 90% labour migrants migrating from the work area.
- Establishing and sustaining mini Migrant information centers in each of the Village (Estate Division) it works.
- Establishing and supporting Migrant societies.
